In the Saint-Hubert wildlife park you can take a closer look at the game living in the Ardennes via various walking paths. Next to the park, there is a didactic hall, a covered barbecue area and a cosy playground where your children can play to their heart's content and in complete safety.

additional description

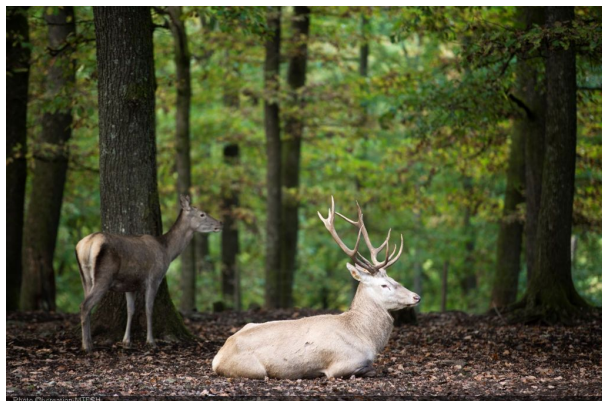
Just 2 km from the city centre, in a beautiful wooded area, you have the opportunity to admire deer, bison, fallow deer, wild boar, and more forest animals that will enchant your children. The animals have a lot of space in this park, but due to the favourable construction, they are very visible. The area of the boars is closed, but you can walk through the area of the deer and approach them up to 10m.

The park is criss-crossed by several footpaths so you can discover these friendly animals while being active and outdoors.

Depending on the period of the year, nature lovers can see little pigs in their striped pyjamas, young deer and other animals strolling along behind their mothers. To learn even more about this fauna, there is a multimedia room with interactive games for children.

Pets are not allowed, except for guide dogs.
